Hi all,

I checked the PLANNED requirements, and saw that most of them had a short progress report attached to them - thanks for that!

However I have some questions regarding some of these reports that I hope to get clarified *before* TCB-14:

EMI:

1) #2279 load balancing possible for CREAM, WMS and LFC

- When is the HA solution for CREAM (and FTS) projected to be available? (date/release/update)
- Balazs requests to remove WMS and LFC from the requirement as HA will *not* be implemented for these.
--> Tiziana, this is an OMB issue, please respond

2) #1189 Server-side management tools of UNICORE

- What is the projected delivery date/release?

3) #1378 Publishing middleware service versions

- The services not implementing this are DPM, FTS, LFC and Hydra.
- Will these services implement this? If so, When is the projected delivery date/release?

4) #1382 Documentation on different implementation of the same service

- The document is not available (as reported) - when will it be?

5) #1186 Some new features for Target System

- Which EMI-2 Update will deliver this feature?

6) #1780 4. Coherency of command line commands, parameters and APIs

- No report was given - can we have an update please?

IGE:

Both #3424 (avoid double counting of URs) and #2699 (Globus middleware publishes accounting data) are announced for IGE 3.0.

IGE 3 is now in the provisioning queue, and RT tickets #4443 and #4444 refer to GridSFAE. Does this version deliver the requested functionality?
