- Resources which
 - are operated by Res. Alloc. processes
- Role of NGI
 - **contribute** resources while **retain rights** to implement local Res. Alloc. policy
- Role of EGI.eu
 - assign resources to users in **easy way**
 - implement own RA policy which is possible based on limitations coming from NGIs

- A way of handling federated pool of resources serving well needs both parties
- 3 options
 - free hand to EGI
 - right to revoke for NGI
 - obligatory negotiations
- Two types of **thresholds** of resources
 - for a given **request**
 - in total for a given **option**

Options explained

- **Free hand:** for requests under some threshold EGI.eu is given free hand to allocate resources
 - usually for small requests
- **Right to revoke:** for requests within some thresholds NGI retains a right to revoke a given request
 - NGI can have a “black list”
- **Obligatory negotiations:** for request above a threshold the customer must negotiate with NGI
 - usually for large requests
