2. Introduction by Chair with outline of aims of this meeting

The VT coordinator highlights that the webex conference will be mainly dedicated to check the status of the gathering process of CTA user requirements related to Science Gateways and to the SSO system (task 2).

4. Review of assigned actions & task progress reports

- Task 1 (Claudio) / Actions: 1.2, 3.1
- Action 1.2 is a continuous action so it is kept open.
- Action **3.1** is kept open because there are still people listed as members of the CTA VT who have not inserted yet their information in the spreadsheet. The coordinator will send a final message asking people to provide their information by Sunday 5 May. After that date the spreadsheet will be definitely closed and the clusterization of the information (on a per country and per activity basis) finalized.
- <u>Task 2</u> (Nadine) / <u>Actions</u>: 4.2 4.5, 5.1, 5.2
