Terminology

Reason

Current terminology confuses CRITICAL test status and tests which are CRITICAL for operations

Terminology

- 1) Current:
 - a) test which is run by Nagios: Nagios test
 - b) test raising alarms on Dashboard and triggering operations procedure: **Critical test**
 - c) test taken into Ava/Rel calculations: < lack of short name>
- 2) Proposed:
 - a) SAM test
 - b) Operators' test
 - c) Availability test
 - d) Test which is in CRITICAL status: Critical test

This procedure **only applies for tests run under OPS VO** and its range is global i.e. **applies for all Operations Centres in EGI project.**

New Operators' test request

Everyone is allowed to submit the request for making the test critical for COD and the request should be **submitted to the Chief Operations Officer**.



Prerequisites

SAM test needs to

- satisfy quality criteria in agreement with the UMD roadmap
- be properly documented
- be present in official nagios package and run for at least 1 month
 - no issues in production infrastructure observed
 - available for validation by COD

Quality criteria needs to be provided by SA1



Validation process

Step	Action on	Action
1	COO	Opens a GGUS ticket to COD to start the process.
2	COD	Checking the status of the Nagios probe to see if it meets the specified quality criteria (to be defined).
3	COD	COD contacts the OMB to request the approval of the new critical test. Date is specified (at least 1 month in future)
4	NGIs	Request to the ROD teams to try making the test OK. 75% OK in total (entire EGI) is understood as threshold for passing to the next step. If not possible to proceed, report problems to OMB.



Validation process

Step	Action on	Action
5	COD	The announcement about new operators' test is broadcasted
6	COD	Add the test to critical tests list wiki page. https://wiki.egi.eu/wiki/Operations:Operations_tests
7	Operations Portal	Mark the test as critical in Operations Portal. This step will be removed when COD gets an access to manage operations tests list in Operational Portal. See Requirements to be implemented
8	COD	Final check. Close parent ticket.

Fundamental changes to "operators' test" require re-validation
