### UMD releases status

#### Next UMD releases

- UMD-3 first update tentative scheduled day is **middle fo June**
- UMD-2 next update tentative scheduled day is **end of June**

#### Status of products verification/staged rollout

The meeting agenda contains an extensive report about the status of the product updates released by EMI and IGE and in the UMD software provisioning process.

#### Updates from the product teams

Cristina updated the StoRM and CREAM sections. Releases expected in one week time, no changes affecting other products expected.

Tomasz updated the QCG section. New major release expected for end of June, that will be the first released officially in UMD.

#### SHA-2 Readiness

Currently EGI is maintaining a wiki page with the product versions supporting SHA-2, using the information gathered by EMI and IGE. The wiki page is accessible here: [SHA-2 support middleware baseline](#).

The version number listed in the wiki page will be used for an active monitoring that will start after the end of EMI-1 decommissioning
