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Authentication & Authorisation Services GÉANT Is Involved





World-wide roaming **network access** (via Wifi) for the international research and education community.

• **KeduGAIN**

World-wide trustworthy exchange of information related to identity, authentication and authorisation (AAI) via the web.



Moonshot takes identity federation and single **sign-on beyond the web** and into remote access, email, instant messaging, file sharing, and more. ("eduroam + eduGAIN = Moonshot")

Developed by Janet (UK), not widely established yet.

eduGAIN (for now) Most Relevant to Research Communities



Why?

Web-based

Most users should be familiar with this already thanks to social media ("Login with Facebook Connect").

Global

Not limited to one country or region. eduGAIN is open to all academic identity federations.

Operated by the community for the community GÉANT together with national research & education networks and their members (universities, research institutes, ...)

Familiar to Users


Already in use at users' home institutions Universities in many countries rely on identity federations.

Availability

It's there already today and coverage is growing quickly!

eduGAIN's Limitations



- Currently most eduGAIN Identity Providers support web authentication only. Non-web profiles (SAML-ECP) are however likely to become more widely deployed in the coming months.
- Only few research communities have user base that is completely federated/eduGAIN-ready. Home-for-the-homeless Identity Provider still needed in most cases.
- Attribute release in some countries and in some federations has yet to be improved.
- User attributes provided by eduGAIN are fairly general (name, email, unique identifier, affiliation). Community-specific attributes still needed.

Example Use-Cases from the Responses




In General:

Grant access to non-public data or restricted functionality to:

- selected users only (e.g. list of unique identifiers)
- large groups of users (e.g. all staff members of higher ed.)
- BGS: "allow trusted users 'early' access to data that is being temporarily withheld from distribution"
- EIDA (hypothetical use-case): Download restricted unencrypted data (350TB) data from 8 data centers via standard protocols and one single account from your home institution with one single registration (vs currently encrypted data with max 8 registrations/passwords currently, two proprietary protocols and one hard-to-extend software implementation).

IsFederated Check Tool How many of your users are federated yet?





- Shows if users' organisations are already federated and eduGAIN-enabled
- Great for research groups to find out how many of their users potentially could already login to their services via eduGAIN
