- Best effort support since more than 1 year
 - Lack of effort
- In case of bugs or security issues, developers won't be able to promptly work on a fix
- Not included in UMD4
- Need to decommission it and move to DIRAC (the only alternative available at the moment)
- 73 WMS servers registered on GOC-DB
 - Supporting several VOs

- Technical details and timeline still to define
- Deployment depends on the allocated effort
- Scenario with either central or regional DIRAC servers:
 - Central (EGI.eu) servers for small VOs
 - NGIs servers for regional VOs (plus some international ones)
 - Managed by largest sites
 - Single instances managed directly by VOs
- Verify how many VOs are really using WMS service
 - From the BDII: 197 VOs with at least 1 WMS instance

- Each NGI providing a WMS verify its usage and inform the VOs about the migration
 - EGI Operations are opening tickets to know the WMS usage
- Possibility to try the DIRAC4EGI instance before the real transition for some VOs
- In a couple of months the decommissioning campaign could start
 - 6 months duration
