Decommissioning WMS servers

- 53 WMS servers registered on GOC-DB
 - 181 VOs with at least 1 WMS instance
- From January 2018, WMS servers can be put in draining:
 - To block the submission of new jobs and to allow the jobs previously submitted to finish
 - Some users/VOs might need to use the service for few weeks more, to agree with them
- EGI Operations will send a new broadcast to the VOs reminding the users the forthcoming WMS decommission
- After the end of February, EGI Operations will open a ticket to the sites that haven't started the decommission process yet

- A central server (DIRAC4EGI) is available for the EGI user communities
 - Ask EGI Operations through a GGUS ticket for configuring the access to the server
