# Monitoring New Features

- **Harmonization of the user facing web interfaces:** ARGO A/R and Status and POEM web interface. In this task:
  - Create one unified theme for all web interfaces and
  - common user sessions, so that users do not have to authenticate on each of them separately
- **Single stop shop for service enablement and configuration.** A new interface that Customers (e.g. VO managers, Infrastructure Managers etc) will be able to:
  - configure the monitoring service to their liking
  - sign up for the service and configure it for their infrastructure with just a few clicks
- **Customer defined thresholds.** The ARGO Monitoring Service is generating Status and A/R reports based on the metric results that it gathers from the execution of the monitoring probes. Each probe has a hard-coded built-in static logic in order to compute the probe status. It does not give us any flexibility in providing different SLA targets to customers. Customers will be able to:
  - create their own probe profile with different thresholds
  - a new probe configuration will be executed as a new test

# Messaging Features

- **Messaging “as a Service”:**
  - Addition of a new tenant
  - Reconfiguration of main characteristics (ex message retention period)
  - Support of number of messages
