- Overview of task activities and internal structure (teams/groups where applicable)
 - Operations and e-Infrastructure Oversight activities contain:
 - Daily operational tasks now performed by COD. These tasks include ticket and alarm oversight.
 - Maintaining and interpretation of support model metrics
 - Organising the ROD forum activities, i.e. f2f meetings, phone conferences, coordinating ROD teams, etc. in order to maintain coherency
 - Representing COD/ROD/1st line requirements in operational tools advisory group (OTAG)
 - Reporting problems to middleware developers and handling COD SU in GGUS
 - Defining process for creating new NGIs
 - ROD SLA monitoring of NGIs



More specfic:

- Put a lot effort in the transition from SAM to Nagios monitoring during the last months of EGEE-III
- Defined procedures for ROC-NGI transition
 - The setup of 14 NGI's (or NGI groups) is currently either in progress or is completed.
 NGIs: Poland, France, Cech Republic, Slovak Republic, Hungary, Turkey, Belarus, NDGF (Scandinavia), Netherlands/Belgium, Ibergrid (Spain/Portugal), Slovenia, Austria, Serbia and Croatia.
- Organised ROD teams workshop, june 1-st and 2-nd.
 - Attendance 51 people
 - A lot of people from the new NGIs, i.e. countries and people not involved in the EGEE SA1
 activity.
 - They were trained for ROD work and operations tools proved to be working good for them
 - They are ready now to take over the responsibility for operations support



Assessment of transition from EGEE-III

- Poland and the Netherlands took over the COD coordination from France.
- COD duty now on a weekly shifts done by the Netherlands and Poland
- Setting up a more regionalised model for monitoring sites was already finished during EGEE-III
- No big issues. Operations did not collapse during the switch from EGEE-III to EGI InSPIRE where tasks and responsibilities wrere taken up by different partners



- Roadmap for Y1
 - The first month's:
 - ROC-NGI transition, bringing in new NGIs
 - Updating documentation, wiki's etc. and transferring docs from CERN to egi.eu.
 - Populating websites, wiki's etc.
 - Phase out CERN-based facilities (mailinglists, wiki's etc.)
 - Changes in operational tools
 - A lot of effort will go into the switch from SAM to Nagios
 - Issues affect the operational tools that we use and also our metrics
