 Organised so that one can make a PDF Book using the wiki BOOK function

- Front page of each section has a small summary
 - Links to subpages of the section in each front page
- Organised to keep information to about a page or so.
 - Easier to read and navigate

- Regional Support
 - Needs some editing
- ROD
 - Needs some editing
- COD

- NOTE: COD pages are a direct link to the Grid Oversight pages
- NOTE: ROD needs some further work to merge information under Grid Oversight pages and here
 - Agnes has some nice workflow diagrams which still need to be incorporated
- NOTE: Regional Support is an OPTIONAL model
 - Based on the old 1st Line Support
 for completeness



Procedure Manuals – cont.

- Approval/revision process needs to be decided upon. Suggestion:
 - Announce at OMB
 - have a 2 week time frame for feedback
 - Approve at following OMB
 - Revisions should be done on a quarterly basis
- Most of the information has been taken from the original procedure manuals.
 - Updates have been applied accordingly
 - Input is required from ROD teams and COD!



Best Practices

- Wiki page has been updated:

- Each BP has it's own page
 - Front page gives the titles, the URL is kept simple
- Approval process?
 - Suggest that it is handled through the (NOC) mailing list – otherwise a BP can languish
