- This is the aim of this presentation
- Service with simple goal
 - Deliver messages from some points to some others
- It is currently highly used by monitoring



The EGI Operations Message Broker Network (PROD)

- A setup of 4 brokers
 - Administratively and geographically separated
 - AUTH
 - CERN
 - SRCE
 - Fully connected mesh
 - Coordinated by GRNET under SA1.4 activity



- Supported as part protocol
- Clients only need to know the endpoints
- Brokers are advertised in BDII
 - Dynamic definition of the broker network
 - The list can be cached
 - Easy to do operations on broker side



Who can use the network?

- Operational tools
 - Aim of the network
- Other applications
 - Should use their own installations
 - No EMI/UMD product for this yet
 - Could be temporary serviced by PROD network
 - If they can fit in the current setup



- Info on the usage:
 - Name, description, contact information
 - Expected activity
 - Needed protocol(s)
 - List of destinations
 - Credentials source
 - ACL requirements
 - Local tool
