- Is there everything clear about the operational procedures?
 - Two responses stating that things were not clear
 - Paragraph about monthly availability/reliability thresholds requires more attention
 - Unclear from the table after how many days step X follows step X=1



- Information provisioning. Have you got the impression that you are provided with sufficient information to do your work as ROD team?
 - 4 respondents claim not to have enough information
 - People doing ROD work manage ARC sites and have no knowledge of gLite middleware
 - Need a deployment guide "from scratch"
 - What is the procedure if a site wants to test some service?
 - NGI_TEST needs more coffee ©



- Are you aware of the ROD newsletter?
 - 7 responded that they are not aware of the newsletter



- If you are aware of the ROD newsletter, do you think it is useful?
 - 24 respondents say that it is useful
 - Nobody had any suggestions to improve it



- Have you got any suggestions for improvements on the operations portal?
 - 11 suggestions were given for improvement
 - A few of them had to do with the speed
 - A master refresh button to refresh all sites on the dashboard at once
 - The possibility to mask long-standing tickets in the dashboard to avoid pollution
 - Improve synchronisation with nagios
 - Possibility to reschedule nagios check from portal
 - Notification on the main view that tickets are expiring
 - The possibility for regional installations to created home-made web pages
 - Distinction between flapping en non-flapping status
 - Allow ticket to synchronise when GGUS ticket is updated



- Have you got any suggestions for the improvement of SAM-Nagios?
 - 12 respondents provided input
 - Synchronisation between nagios and dashboard
 - Improved documentation of the tests
 - Unprotected display of Nagios test results
 - Fewer probes
 - Not mixing CE tests and SE tests. CE tests fail when SE is down
 - Alarms raised for resources not in GOCdb
 - Too many messages for transient problems
 - More detailed info on errors. History not clear
 - Implement flap detection
 - Improve reliability of the duration column
 - Nagios probe to monitor certificate lifetime of DPM disk nodes, not just the master node



- Have you got any suggestions for the improvement of myEGI?
 - 4 respondents provided input
 - An auto-reload function, just like in Nagios
 - The history view should state how many nagios tests have been performed over a given period
 - A "size by" attribute in the Gridmap View section



- Have you got any suggestions for the improvement of the GOCdb?
 - 10 respondents have provided input
 - Too slow
 - It should be more simple to reduce a downtime
 - Help page on roles and permissions
 - Reminder email that requests for roles need to be approved
 - Free text search to avoid having to go through the long drop down list
 - Having both glite-APEL and APEL service types is confusing.
 - GOCdb3 was better in looking up and changing information
 - Don't like the r/rw separation. This could be done with roles
 - Set a title on each page to reflect the information displayed
 - Set "OUTAGE" as default when declaring a downtime
 - Possibility to schedule a downtime for the whole NGI
 - There should be a clock available showing UTC and it should be possible to schedule downtime in NGI local time



- Is the ROD manual which is currently in a draft state sufficient for you to do your work?
 - There were 6 responses saying no to this question
 - The authors think it is awesome compared to the other ROD documents. Their suggestion is to improve the rest to get closer to this doc
 - Not sufficient
 - it is too large and hard to read
 - Now it is really very short draft
 - There are a few inconsistencies
 - National specific duties
