What is koji

Package building infrastructure done right ©


 Clearly separated services that achieve one specific task

Scalable according to the needs

Supported by a large, active community



Build, tag, serve procedure





Package Building





Submit a build task

- Let koji do its magic
 - Checks-out the SCM
 - Prepares the source RPM
 - Builds the package from SRPM



Package Building



- Scratch builds
 - Test your build
- Mock build environment
 - Requirements in .spec file
- Build logging
 - Detailed logging
 - Build logs are available for future reference
- 1-click resubmit for failed tasks

 - Project/application specific
 - Rollout process specific
- Authorization

EGI JRA1 SAM case

- Stage tags
 - Development tag
 - Testing tag
 - Release tag
- Per release tag
 - Each SAM update



Serving your product



- Usable by default
 - YUM repositories for machines
 - Repoview for humans
 - SRPMs for developers
- Based on tags
 - No need for new grouping
 - Staged rollout
- Rsync it
 - Serve it yourself
 - Available on request basis



Manage repositories




HellasGrid case

- Many package providers
- Source not always available
- Other build-tools in place
- Koji's solution
 - One tag per provider
 - Inheritance
