During the actions review the following items were discussed:

- OCCI/Jcloud (Action 08/07): implementation gap in the current cloud managers. The differences between Jcloud and OCCI, the status of the OCCI implementation of Jcloud documented on the OCCI web site. The necessity to document how the lack of OCCI implementations impacts the federation (Action 03/09) and how Jcloud could be useful for the Federation prototype (action 08/07).
- OCCI server port to OpenStack (Action 02/09): GWDG does not have enough men power to port their OpenNebula server to OpenStack or Jcloud. There are on-going projects to implement OCCI for OpenStack/Jcloud. These projects should be documented (Action 02/10).
- Blog: everyone has to send a mail to the blog admin asking to be given permission to post. For more details see Michel's mail on the mailing list about blogging. (Action 03/10).

Agenda

Scenario 1 report

- A lot of activity is reported. Three volunteers for the matrix texting, all using OpenNebula and so in the condition to run OCCI-based tests (Actions 05/10, 6/10).
- Wiki, Workbench Scenario 1 section updated.
- Testing matrix will be extended to other providers as soon as further OCCI implementations will be available. Meanwhile, the other providers will be able to run the tests of Scenario 1 via Jcloud. This should cover all the current resource providers.
- Deadline extended by one week to the end of the month (Action 04/10).

Report Scenario 2

- Still no users registered. Tests for Scenario 2 should be devised and a call for volunteers among the Task Force members should be placed. Real users should come on board later on when we will have something to offer alongside some documentation on how to use it (Action 7/10).
- CloudSigma is not going to implement OCCI in the foreseeable future. While waiting for an OCCI binding for Jcloud to be available, the tests for the capabilities of Scenario 1-6 will be run through Jcloud. User communities will be able to use Jcloud too or any other interface they will like to use for any given provider.
