#### Scenario 4 report

- Feedback from the providers is needed:
  - $\circ$  what information they are collection for account at the moment;
  - what information they intend to collect in the future.

The goal is to to reach a common language about cloud accounting shared among the community of our Resource Provider. On these bases, the accounting system capabilities will be defined.

- This review and discussion process will be the core topic for the upcoming F2F meeting (Action 3/11).
- Start to document the Scenario progress on the wiki (Action 2/11).

#### **Scenario 5 report**

- There are three volunteers for a pilot Nagios installation (CESGA, JR1 and OeRC).
- Once the Nagios instances will be available, the workgroup will develop an initial set of simple probes.







- It has been clarified that the monitoring activity involves only the cloud infrastructure not the internal status of the VMs that are running on it.
- The progress of the Scenario should be documented on the wiki (Action 4/11), including design details about the probes and the parameters that they should monitor (Action 5/11).

#### Scenario 6 report

- The VM image used for testing the Scenario 1 capabilities will be used also to run the tests for Scenario 2.
