

The GÉANT Community Programme


- Brings the NRENs and Research and Education Community together to tackle common challenges




- Approved by the GÉANT Community Programme Committee, June 30, 2021
 - for a first initial year of work
 - Following two main community events (Jan 27, June 25 in 2021)
- With the following mandate from NRENs:
 - to gather NRENs' efforts on eHealth support
 - exploit synergies
 - exchange best practices
 - seek specific collaborations with Health related projects
- Goal for the TF is to implement the work plan and include additional work items if needed

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Outcome and take-home messages from the Community at the first eHealth baselining event

- Cloud, AAI, Security, Data Access policies are very relevant domains to this community, overall
- **Artificial Intelligence and ML** applied to medical data sets are key technologies requiring the NRENs community to provide support for
- NRENs well off to provide privacy preserving/secure services to research eHealth institutions
 - Starting from storage and data sharing services
 - Liaising with the activities carried out within the Community Cloud task
- There is a common need to acquire additional information on latest EU directives/communications and promoted new concepts on eHealth
 - EU eHealth Dataspace
- Key areas where support at the policy level is required and developments are needed identified in
 - Data Access policies
 - Enforcement of standards and FAIR data approach
 - Trusted research environments
 - Evangelization to Hospitals and their staff
- Consensus on common interest to know more about funding opportunities for the community

Roadmap and recommendations from the Steering Committee

- **Dissect the problem** of supporting eHealth in its natural domains
 - Infrastructure Interoperability
 - Ethical Issues
 - Regulatory matters
 - Business related
- Acquire information on the exact **status of national eHealth initiatives** in each EU country, including the legal aspects/frameworks
- Push for the adoption and the enforcement of standards allowing interoperability
- Training, Training, Training!
- Liaise with the national eHealth initiatives and large international collaboration in eHealth



Envisageable role for the NRENs in supporting eHealth

- Liaise with the EC and inform our eHealth community connected institutions about new project. calls, EC regulations, EC communications
- Provide input to the community discussions on how to improve support for eHealth
- Liaise with national eHealth initiatives
 - Identifying collaboration domains (Network, eInfrastructures, Storage Services, Cloud)
- **Provide Security Trainings for the community** to ensure tools, processes, DCs, LANs are secu
- **Primary use of Health Data and Telemedicine:**
 - Provide high bandwidth and enable ubiquitous teleconsulting, diagnosys, cure
- Secondary use of Health Data for Research:
 - Push for the adoption of our open community standards (e.g. AAI, AAI-a-a-S)
 - Ensure FAIR access to research data avoiding vendor lock-in
 - Provide eHealth specific services (e.g. anonymization, secure data transfer..)
 - Provide support to the eInfrastructure for secondary usage of electronic health data
 - Trusted Research Environments / Secure Processing Environments
 - (EHDS)
 - Liaise with other key initiatives in Europe (e.g. EuroHPC JU)



Suggested focus areas for a SIG on eHealth

- EHDS: What is the role that existing eInfrastructures and research communities will play in MyHealth@EU and HealthData@EU?
- EHDS: Secure Processing Environments and Trusted Research Environments
- EOSC and the Common European Data Spaces
- EC regulations like DA, DGA, Al act
- How should our community relate to the national eHealth Initiatives to ensure the community of eHealth users gets all required support?
- Share experiences on pilots on Trust and Identity, Storage services, Cloud focusing of supporting the eHealth Community
- Showcase success stories and share experiences on providing access to compute resources (Cloud, HPC, HTC) for AI, ML
 - Keep the eHealth User Community well linked to HPC community/EuroHPC JU


Goals and scope for the 2024 eHealth Survey for NRENs

- Help understanding the landscape around eHealth and managing Digital Health Data
- Underlying question is: is it time, do we have the resources, time and will to step up our efforts on specifically targeting the Health Community, possibly spawning something beyond the SIG ?
- How relevant is Health and how required is the management of sensitive data / medical data within our Community?
- How much awareness is there about the latest regulatory processes about Health, starting from the proposal of the European Health Data Space?
- Is it "time to act", also in liaising with key, flagship EU initiatives (e.g. Health Data Hub, THEDAS..)

Structure of the Survey


Three main survey sections:















Do you have an appointed staff member to join the SIG-Digital Health Data (SIG-DHD) activities (formerly called TF-eHealth)?



Would you like to see your involvement in the domain of Digital Health growing in the next 2-4 years?





















Should NRENs coordinate more with each other to jointly defined actions to be carried out collectively?



Research data-set transfer service on-top of network

Common PaaS cloud middleware for integrated Trusted Research

Pan-European Sovereign research data object-storage Supporting Research Infrastructures & Data Repositories, interfacing with HPC

Enabling seamless dataset management (moving on from bits and files)

Overcoming challenges in point-to-point data transfers

Optimising exploitation of network infrastructure

Maximising the network performance perceived by users

Unified Platform-as-a-Service middleware for Virtual/Trusted research environment

Integrates NREN services (T&I, security)

Deployable on any infrastructure cloud (commercial and community)

Provides Virtual/Trusted Research Environment functionality to end-users

Pan-European sovereign object-storage infrastructure for research data (archives)

Unified hardware platform, collectively procured

Simple object-storage interfaces

Enables temporary and flexible use of non-sovereign platforms

Ensures data safety with a copy in a sovereign solution

Capitalises on scale efficiencies and collective procurement capability

 A natural evolution of the forthcoming Research Dataset transfer network could be the provisioning of TREs and SPEs via a dedicated slice of this infrastructure, aimed at complying with stricter privacy and security constraints

No implementation plans available yet - room for work in GN5-2 starting 1.1.2025
