CentOS7 decommission and migration to EL8/EL9 (I)

PROC16 Decommissioning of unsupported software

- end of life in June
 - Migration to either EL8 or EL9
- **Broadcast** circulated in June
- UMD5 will include middleware for EL9 Handling some issues to release it
- Enabling the metric to detect CentOS7 endpoint The NGIs can open tickets against sites to track the migration

Sites encouraged to migrate their service to supported OS versions due to CentOS 7

CentOS7 decommission and migration to EL8/EL9 (II)

<u>PROC16</u> Decommissioning of unsupported software

- While UMD5 is not released yet
 - install the product versions that are already published in EPEL9
 - use the WLCG repository for products like: APEL, BDII, LCMAPS, UI and WN metapackages
 - other products might be added if needed
 - use the repositories of the product teams





VOMS upgrade to EL9

- Agreed with INFN to extend the support of VOMS until the end of the year
 - Users and middleware still need the use of VOMS credentials
- INFN is going to release VOMS on EL9
 - server, C/C++ APIs, and clients
 - JAVA APIs and clients
 - Completing release notes and documentation before the announcement
- Then we can open tickets to track the migration of the servers
- Currently there are <u>28 VOMS endpoints in production</u> •

STORM upgrade to EL9

- INFN is working to release the several STORM components on EL9
 - Dependency on ARGUS not needed any longer
 - GridFTP plugin not needed any longer
- <u>31 StoRM endpoints</u> currently in production (by querying the BDII)
