Most common Core integration

1. Understand and define main use cases (user-centric perspective) for the AAI integration that we want to support in the project
 - a. AAI int Use case1: As a Pilot node I want to integrate a number of services with EOSC so my users can...
 - b. AAI int Use case2: want to integrate a number of services with EOSC Innovation sandbox to test Sandbox capabilities
 - c. ...
2. Break down the use cases into necessary technical and operational steps, map them to AAI core services
 - a. For AAI int use case2
 - i. a single Pilot rep needs to log in in the sandbox using their credential
 - ii. fill in the provider form
 - iii. wait for acceptance
 - iv. ...
3. Connect Pilot nodes with the use cases
4. Conduct the same exercise for other Core Services (during WP15 meetings)
