- Certified status:
 - LFC and DPM 1.7.4-8:
 - The 1.7.4-7 (status on hold), was discovered a race condition in a voms lib affecting DPM (and LFC) only visible in high load.
 - Glite-CLUSTER, a new node types:
 - To be deployed in the lcg-CE or CREAM, permits to have multiple clusters published in the info system with different characteristics.
- Ready for production:
 - dCache 1.9.5-19 (golden release)

- Certified status:
 - UI and VOBOX (version 3.2.8)
 - Only one EA team each, **need more!!**
- Ready for production but “On Hold”:
 - Site BDII 5.1
 - On hold due to some technical issues in the full set of packages. Functionality has been in staged rollout with outcome: success.

- Milestone MS402 in AMB for review, final stage.
